TENDER FEE AND EMD

- 1.1** Tender fee of ₹ 500/- in the form of Demand Draft (in original) of any scheduled Bank drawn in favour of “**Director, Directorate of Lighthouses & Lightships, Cochin**” payable at Ernakulum.
- 1.2** Earnest Money Deposit amount to ₹.42,100/- shall be furnished in the form of **Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit receipt (FDR)** of any Nationalised / scheduled bank in favour of “**Director, Directorate of Lighthouses and Lightships, Cochin**”, payable at Ernakulum.
- 1.3** The **EMD and Tender Fee in original should be submitted to this office on or before 02.02.2022 (up to 15.00hrs)**. Otherwise bids shall be summarily rejected.
- 1.4** The details of work are available in the tender document which can be downloaded from Central Public Procurement (CPP) Portal <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> and the tender is to be submitted online only on <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> up to last date and time of submission of tender. **Sale of physical tender document is not applicable.**
- 1.5** **Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) of the prospective bidders is required for online bidding.**

- 1.6 Bidding is open to all eligible bidders meeting the eligibility criteria as defined. Bidders are to note and satisfy themselves that they fulfil eligibility criteria.
- 1.7 Technical evaluation shall be carried out by a committee. The decision of the Director, Directorate of Lighthouses & Lightships, Cochin in deciding the successful bidder shall be final and binding on the bidders.
- 1.8 The Bidder shall carefully read eligibility criteria and instructions to bidders, Technical requirement and scope of work, general and special conditions of contract, all other documents in connection with the tender. The bidder shall quote his rates, keeping all above points in mind.
- 1.9 The tender document comprises **Civil maintenance of Lighthouse tower & staff quarters at Vypin Lighthouse in Ernakulam District**. The Director, Directorate of Lighthouses & Lightships, Cochin reserves to himself the right of accepting the tender, bidder shall be bound to perform the same at the quoted rates.
- 1.10 Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bid is strictly prohibited. The tenders submitted by the bidders, who resort to canvassing, shall be summarily rejected.
- 1.11 Those bidders whose near relatives are posted as accountant or as a Gazetted Officer in any capacity in the Directorate General of Lighthouses & Lightships shall not be permitted to Bid. The prospective bidder shall also intimate the names of persons who are working, with him in any capacity or subsequently employed by him, who are near relative to any Gazetted Officer in the Directorate General of Lighthouses & Lightships shall or in the Ministry of Shipping. Any breach of this condition by the bidder shall render him ineligible. By the term 'near relative' is meant wife, husband, parents and grandparent, children and grandchildren, brother and sisters uncles, aunts and corresponding in laws.
- 1.12 The bidder shall disclose any payment made or proposed to be made to any intermediaries (agents etc.) in connection with the bid.
- 1.13 No Gazetted Officer of Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor without prior permission of the Government of India in writing for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service. The contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of these employees is found at any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission Government of India as aforesaid, before submission of the bid or engagement in the Contractor's service.
